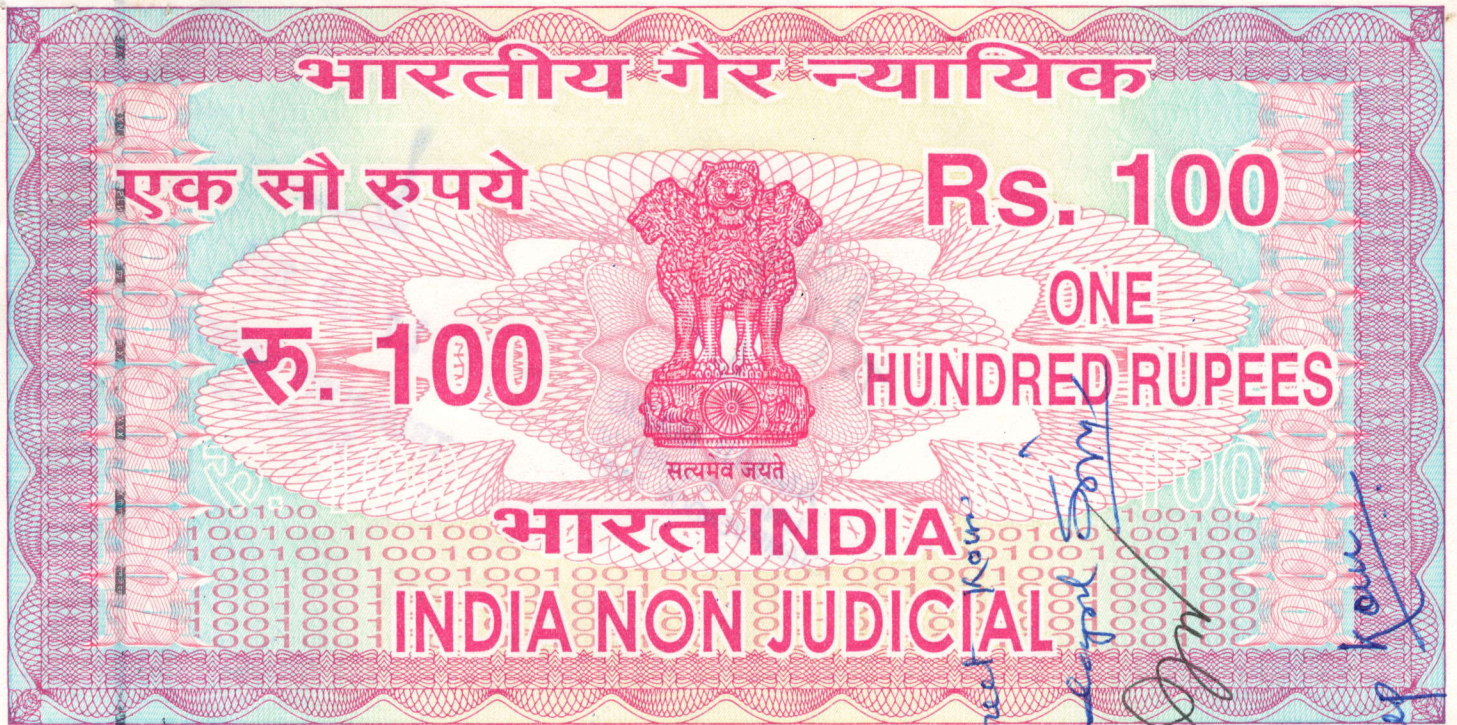

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(Hereinafter called " The Trustees" which expression shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof be deemed to include the survivors or survivor of them and the trustees or trustee for the time being of these presents and their heirs, executors and administrators of the last surviving trustee, their or his assignees) of the **OTHER PART:**

WHEREAS the party hereto of the first part is possessed of the sum of Rs. 21,000/- (Rs. Twenty one thousand Only) as her absolute property and she is desirous of creating a Charitable Educational Trust for the benefit of the humanity at large.

AND WHEREAS in pursuance of the above object the Settlor is establishing a public charitable trust known as "GURJAS EDUCATIONAL TRUST"

AND WHEREAS each of the parties hereto of the "Other Part" has individually and jointly has agreed to act as Trustees of the Trust, proposed by the party of the "First Part".

AND WHEREAS nothing contained in this deed shall be deemed to authorize the trustees to do any act which may in any way be construed statutory modification



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thereof and all activities of the trust shall be carried out with a view to benefit the public at large, without any profit motive and in accordance with the provisions of the Income-tax Act, 1961 or any statutory modification thereof.

AND WHEREAS the trust is hereby expressly declared to be a public charitable trust and all the provisions of this deed are to be constituted accordingly.

NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. SETTLEMENT

The party of the first part, the Settlor, does hereby settle the sum of Rs.21,000/- (Rs. Twenty one thousand only) in Trust, with the name and for the objects hereinafter stated, by delivering the said amount in cash which the party of the other part, the Trustees, have accepted the receipt of which they do hereby acknowledge, to hold the same in and to the Trustees with the powers and obligations as provided hereinafter



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2. NAME AND CONSTITUTION OF THE TRUST

The Settlor does hereby declare and constitute the trust which shall be known as "GURJAS EDUCATIONAL TRUST", hereinafter referred to as the "Trust" with the object and constitution and the terms and condition of the trust as set forth here under.

The office of the trust shall be situated at BANSBARI GOAN, P.O. HIJUGURI, TINSUKIA, ASSAM which may be changed from time to time to such other place or places as the trustees may deem fit and proper at their discretion. The Trust may also carry on its work at any other place or places, as decided by the Trustees.

3. FUNDS OF THE TRUST

The Trustees may accept donations, grants, subscriptions, aids or contributions from any person, Government, Local authorities or any other charitable institutions, in cash or in kind including immovable property without any encumbrance, but the Trustees shall not accept any receipt with any condition or terms inconsistent with the objects of the Trusts.

While applying such receipts to the objects, the Trustees shall respect the directions, if any, by the grantor. Any receipt with specific direction to treat the same as part of the corpus of the Trust or separate fund shall be funded accordingly.

The funds of the Trust shall be solely utilized towards the objects of the Trust and no portion of it shall be utilized for payment to Trustees / Beneficiaries any sum by way of profits, interest, dividends etc.

4. INVESTMENTS

- a. All monies, which shall not immediately required for current needs shall be invested by the Trustees in eligible securities and investments, or in banks. Such investments shall be in the name of Trust or Trustees.
- b. That the trustees shall invest the trust fund, carry on any business with the trust fund and/or enter into partnership on behalf of the trust, as they may deem fit.
- c. That the trustees shall manage the trust fund and investments thereof as a prudent man would do the same. They shall recover all outstanding and meet all recurring and other expenses incurred in the upkeep or management thereof.
- d. That the trustees shall receive and hold the income of the trust on behalf and for the benefit of the beneficiaries under the trust.

5. OBJECTS OF THE TRUST

- i. To provide sound education (including Computer education) to children of all communities irrespective of their race, religion, caste or creed in general and to prepare them to become mature and responsible citizens of the country through all around physical, intellectual, academic, moral and spiritual development based on values derived from life.

- ii. To start establish run take over or manage and maintain schools, with an object to provide sound pre-primary, primary, middle, secondary, senior secondary and higher education to children by seeking recognition and Affiliation from the education departments and concerned Govt. Authorities.
- iii. To run, maintain or assist any educational or other institution for coaching, guidance, counseling or vocational training or to grant individual scholarships for poor, deserving and needy students for elementary and higher education.
- iv. To conduct research in education and other disciplines on the different subject relating to education.
- v. To open, found, establish, promote, set up, run ,maintain, assist, finance, support and/or aid and help in the setting up the different kinds of technical or non technical schools, engineering colleges, management colleges, university. Medical colleges, Nursing colleges and other establishments or institution for advancement of all kinds of education including vocational education & center and knowledge (also get the permission from the competent authority /department, if required.)
- vi. To arrange and to manage the vocational training institution in typing, short hand, computer, fine arts, crafts, music, painting, dancing, yoga, physical education and in other professional training subject/courses.
- vii. To open, found, establish, promote, set up, run, maintain, assist, finance support and/or help the various charitable, educational, medical, technical/non-technical, industrial, vocational and agricultural institution.
- viii. To promote, establish, support, and finance the social and school activities by promoting awareness classes, competition, and exhibitions, cultural programs and to keep prizes, awards for their excellence performance, to provide food, stationery, cloth, medical, and other luxurious facilities for students.

- ix. To work for the development of the religious minority communities such as Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Buddhists and Parsees in general and for the development of the Sikh community and Sikh language in particular as because the trustees belongs to Sikh minority group.
- x. The strive for giving effect to the Article 30(1) in The Constitution of India which states as follows:
"All minorities, whether based on religion or language, shall have the right to establish and administer educational institutions of their choice."
- xi. To borrow or receive financial (money with or without interest) and non financial assistant from bank, government, non-government, privately, and by the other means as approved by the government of trust as per the terms and condition.
- xii. To employ, engage or hire appropriate staff, workers, legal experts and other professional for the smooth running of the work of trust and to pay appropriate fees, salary, wages, and stipends as required.
- xiii. To organize Seminars, meetings, Press conferences and other lawful gatherings from time to time.
- xiv. To invest the fund of the trust not immediately required in mutual funds, UTI, Securities or Deposits as are permitted by the law for the time being.
- xv. To Purchase/acquire lands and/or the buildings in the name of the trust for the upliftment and fulfillment of the aims of the trust.
- xvi. To erect, construct, alter, maintain, sell, lease, mortgage, transfer, improve, develop, manage and control all or any part of the property or the building of the above trust, necessary or convenient for the purpose of the attainment of the sums and objects of the trust.

- xvii. To publish souvenir and other literature in the different languages and subjects this may be useful for general welfare of the general public.
- xviii. To do such things /acts/activities/which are necessary and which may be incidental or conducive to the attainment of any of the objects.
- xix. Trust will invest its money and funds according to sec.-11(5) of Income Tax Act.
- xx. All the incomes, earnings, moveable/or immovable properties of the trust shall be solely utilized and applied towards the promotion of its aims and objects only as set forth in the Memorandum of the trust and no profits thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividends, bonus, profits or in any manner whatsoever to the present or the past members of the trust or to any person claiming through any one or more of the present or the past members. No members of the trust shall have any personal claim on any moveable or immovable properties of the trust or make any profits, whatsoever, by virtue of this membership.

6. MANAGEMENT OF TRUST

a. Board of Trustees

Trust shall be governed by the Board of Trustees consisting of not less than 3 (Three) but not more than 10 (Ten) members.

b. Constitutions of The Board:

- (i) The Board of Trustees shall elect among themselves a Chairman, secretary, treasurer, who shall hold the office for a period of two years or until such time the new officer bearers of the Board are elected.
- (ii) The Chairman shall be entitled to preside over the meetings of the Board of trustees.
- (ii) In the absence of the Chairman the trustees present may elect among themselves a Trustee to chair the meeting.

- c. The following parties shall be the First Trustees and they shall automatically form the Board of Trustees and they shall be Permanent Trustees, not liable to retire.
- i. **Mr. Gurdayal Singh**
 - ii. **Mr. Harpal Singh**
 - iii. **Ms. Baldeep Kour**
- d. The Trustees may from time to time frame rules for the conduct and regulations of the meetings of trustees.
- e. One half of the Board of Trustees or a minimum of 2 trustees, whichever is higher, shall constitute the QUORUM for the Board of Trustees meetings.
- f. The meeting of the Board shall be convened after giving at least a week's notice unless all the Trustees agree to accept a shorter notice.
- g. The Board of Trustees will decide all matters mutually.
- h. Resolution passed without any meeting of the Trustees but by circulation thereof and evidenced in writing under the hands of two thirds of the trustees shall be as valid and effectual as a Resolution duly passed at a meeting of Trustees.
- i. The Trustees may exercise all the powers vested in them, under these regulations or by law, by resolution passed at a meeting of the Board of Trustees or in circulation. Notice of the resolution in writing shall be sent to all Trustees.
- j. The number of Trustees shall be not less than three and not more than ~~ten~~ . In the event of any trustee ceasing to be a Trustee by reason of death, resignation or physical or mental incapacity or otherwise, the remaining trustees shall have power to appoint any other person in his place as trustee and on such appointment all the Trust Fund will vest in him along with other trustees.
- k. The disposal of capital assets and taking of loans shall not be done in circulation.

7. The trustees shall from time to time after meeting the expenses of and incidental to the management of the Trust Properties and of the Trust decide the particular object or objects for which the income or corpus of the trust fund or Properties for the time being available shall be applied.

8. The trustees may accept any donation or contribution in cash or in kind from any person, firm, company, corporation, associations, institution or trust (including the settlor or the trustees or any of them) for the furtherance of the objects of the trust or for any one or more of them upon such terms and conditions as they may in their absolute discretion think fit and which are not inconsistent with the objects of the trust. The trustees may also take over the management of any other charitable or public institutions on such terms as they think fit and may manage such institutions.

9. POWERS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

i. The Board of Trustees shall have full control of management of all the affairs of the Trust and of the income, assets and funds of the Trust.

ii. Without affecting the generality of powers and functions of the trustees to manage and administer the trust, the Board of Trustees shall have the following functions.

a. To determine from time to time, to commence, to take up, to abandon, to vary and add to the charitable objects for which the funds of the trust shall be used and to all of and allocate to each of the objects such portion of the funds as they deem fit.

b. To invest the income, assets and funds of the Trust in any manner authorized by law relating to Trusts.

c. To hold the income, assets or funds of the Trust either in the name of the Trust or in the name of Trustees designated by the Board.

- d. To open one or more bank accounts for the Trust and in its name or in the names of the Trustees or any of them with any Bank/s as the Trustees may deem fit and deposit Moneys of the Trust in such accounts and to give instructions to the bankers as to persons entitled to operate there on, whether the same be or become over drawn or not.
- e. To enter into contracts or arrangements with any person or body to further the purposes of the Trust.
- f. To utilize the facilities and activities at present run by the Trust for furthering the objects of the trust and on such terms and conditions and on such payments as may agreed to.
- g. To sell, lease or otherwise dispose of any movable and immovable properties, assets and goods of the Trust for the said purpose, authorize any of them to execute deed and register the same and take such further action as may be deemed necessary to conclude the transaction or comply with the requirements.
- h. To acquire any immovable or moveable property, required for carrying out the objects of the Trust, by way of purchase, lease, gift, license or easement basis or otherwise howsoever.
- i. The Trustees shall be entitled to such remuneration or pay as decided by the trust for the services provided in various capacity viz. principal, vice-principal, headmaster, teacher, manager, administrator, secretary, accountant, librarian etc. out of the Trust Fund.
- j. The trustees may sell/lease their land/buildings/vehicles to the trust on such amount/value as may be decided by the trust.

k. To lease, buy or make any arrangement to construct building for furtherance of trust objects with any Body, individual or Trust.

l. To employ staff of all kinds necessary or useful for the carrying out of the objects of the trust.

m. To borrow any moneys from any person Firm; Company or Body for any of the purposes of the Trust on such, terms as the Trustees may deem fit and with or without furnishing securities and in particular to mortgage or charge any property or assets, movable or immovable of the Trust vested in the Trust to secure repayment of any moneys so borrowed and if necessary to deposit the title deeds of the Trust.

n. To mortgage or charge any property or asset movable or immovable of the Trust or vested in the Trustees in favors of the Government or any Department thereof in pursuance of the rules of the Government or any Department there for the said purpose, authorize any of them to execute deeds and register the same and take such further action as may be deemed necessary to conclude the transactions or comply with the requirements.

o. To frame rules and bye-laws for the conduct of the business of the Trust of its transactions and of the committees of Board of Trustees and to alter amend or cancel the same; provided that no such alteration amendment or cancellation shall be made unless the same is approved by the Board at a meeting at which at least three - fourths of the members are present and by a majority or two - thirds of the members present.

p. To amalgamate the trust with other institution, association, trust or organization having public charitable objects and purposes with the consent of two third of trustee in writing.

q. The board of the trustee shall be entitled to sue in the name of the trust and may similarly be sued in the name of the trust.

r. To arrange for and/or authorize the signing or execution of any agreement, contract, instrument, document or any other paper or writing required to be signed or executed on behalf of the trustees by any two of the trustees to be nominated in this behalf by the Board of Trustees and to make the same effective and binding as if the said agreement, contract, instrument or document or paper or writing were signed by all the trustees.

s. To appoint or make provision for the appointment of a sub-committee of trustees and/or others to attend to or supervise or conduct specified jobs or functions or trust matters in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations as the trustees may prescribe.

t. To authorize any one or more trustees to hold any property or any fund or any investment of the trust subject however to the terms of these presents in such manner and subject to such terms and conditions, rules and regulations as the Board of Trustees may from time to time think fit and proper.

u. To spend any portion of the corpus or the income of the trust fund for purchasing any land and or constructing any building or buildings for and in the name of the trust for the purpose of carrying out promoting and/or executing any or all of the objects of the trust.

v. The Board of Trustees may, by a unanimous vote of all the trustees for the time being except the trustee proposed to be removed, remove any trustee, from office after finding the trustee proposed to be removed guilty of serious misconduct in relation to or concerning the trust estate or trust affairs and after arriving at a definite conclusion that for the reasons to be recorded in writing the continuance of the trustee proposed to be removed as trustee or these presents was desirable keeping to the objects of the trust in view and other related or connected matters provided however that no conclusion of such guilt shall be arrived at without giving to the trustee proposed to be removed a full and fair opportunity of explaining his conduct and/or the charges leveled against him for his removal. And the decision of the Board of trustees in this behalf shall be final and binding and shall not be called in question anywhere.

10. ACCOUNTS

Regular and correct accounts of the Trust, its funds, receipts and expenditure shall be maintained. The Trustees shall appoint one or more chartered accountants to audit the accounts of the trust and fix his or their remuneration. The accounts of the Trust shall be audited by qualified chartered accountants at 31st of March every year. The Trust shall pay the annual remuneration for the auditors. Every appointment of the Auditors shall be for one year and the retiring Auditors shall be eligible for re- appointment.

11. INDEMNITY

In the professed execution of the Trust and powers hereof one Trustee being an individual shall not be liable

- a. For any loss to the Trust funds arising by any reason for investments made in good faith or
- b. For the negligence, fraud of any agent employed by him/her or by any other Trustees hereof although the employment of such agent was not strictly necessary for expedience, provided due care and caution has been exercised by the Trustee as a normal prudent person would act under such circumstances; or
- c. For any mistake/s or omission/s made in good faith by any Trustee hereof.

12. ANY OTHER OBJECT - UTILIZATION FOR OTHER PURPOSES

If the purpose and objects for which the Trust has been created fail and cannot be fulfilled, the Trustees shall be at liberty to apply the Trust fund and the property which is the object of this Trust to any other object of a like nature which the trustees may think proper after prior consultation with the supporting bodies and income tax authorities to ensure the income of which is not subject to tax.

13. IRREVOCABLE

This Trust is irrevocable.

14. AMALGAMATION

The trustees may amalgamate the trust with another Charitable Trust or Institution having similar objects.

15. DISSOLUTION

The dissolution of the Trust may be affected by a special resolution passed by a majority of three-fourth of the Trustees present at the Special meeting convened for the purpose and with the consent of the Chairman of the Trust there remains after the satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid or distributed amongst the Trustees of the Trust, but shall be given or transferred to some other like institutions having same Aims and Objects to be determined by the Board of Trustees at or before the time of Dissolution
